



A RECORD THIRD WORKSAFE PLATINUM STATUS AWARDED TO BETHESDA HEALTH CARE

Bethesda Health Care in Claremont has retained their WorkSafe Platinum status for a further two years. This is the third time that the health provider has received this prestigious award, and they remain the only hospital in WA to receive this accolade.

Hospital Board Chair Dr Neale Fong, along with Bethesda Health Care CEO Ms Yasmin Naglazas, were presented with the WorkSafe Plan Platinum Certificate of Achievement today by Mr Ian Munns, WorkSafe WA Commissioner.

To achieve Platinum WorkSafe Award recognition, organisations have to demonstrate a rating of 90% or more in every element of the WorkSafe Plan in the areas of Management Commitment, Planning, Consultation, Hazard Management and Training and Supervision as well as an annual reduction in either the incidence rate or frequency rate of lost time injury.

WorkSafe Plan Certificates of Achievement are presented at three levels:

- Silver Certificates: organisations meeting minimum standards
- Gold Certificates: organisations demonstrating good progress toward a best practice approach to safety and health management
- Platinum Certificates: organisations that achieve highest standards.

Bethesda Health Care CEO, Ms Yasmin Naglazas said that “our management and staff are committed to maintaining a safe work environment, which is can be clearly demonstrated through our ongoing recognition from WorkSafe. It is an amazing achievement over the past six years to retain a platinum rating, especially in a hospital environment”.

“Our commitment to safety is a team effort. I am particularly proud that we continued to achieve high standards of safety through last year’s redevelopment project, which saw the addition to two new operating theatres, and expansion of existing hospital facilities”.
