The 1<sup>st</sup> prize of a Dean Alston framed original was initially donated by Dean for our Palliative Care fundraiser late last year featuring fashion icon Donna Karan and international photographer Russell James. It was won by a staff member and donated back to Bethesda for another fund raiser.
