GP Education on Shoulder Treatment at Bethesda Hospital

The next General Practitioner (GP) Education night at Bethesda Hospital in Claremont will be on Tuesday 5th August 2014, and will feature presentations by orthopaedic surgeons from Perth Shoulder Clinic.

Surgeons Grant Booth and Sven Goebel will be speaking on the topic **“Diagnosis and Treatment of Common Shoulder Disorders”** to up to 50 local GP’s.
