



GP EDUCATION FOCUSSES ON SHOULDERS

The next Bethesda Health Care GP Education night on Thursday 25 June 2015 will feature presentations by orthopaedic surgeons from Perth Shoulder Clinic entitled 'Diagnosis and Treatment of Common Shoulder Disorders'.

Up to 40 local General Practitioners are expected to attend the professional development seminar at the Claremont based hospital to listen to presentations by Drs Grant Booth and Sven Goebel.

Specific outcomes from the education session for CPD points include:

- Making a clinical and radiological diagnosis for common shoulder disorders
- Current surgical treatment options for: shoulder instability and arthritis; and rotator cuff repairs and impingement.

This is the third time that Perth Shoulder Clinic has been included in the popular GP Education program, which is now in its third year. Future topics include Orthopaedics, Skin Cancer treatment and Plastic Surgery.
