About the role

About you

The roles would suit doctors who are keen to work in a private hospital setting managing perioperative care for surgical patients, or doctors interested in pursuing a career in general hospital care or trainees (GP or rural generalist or specialist trainees) who wish to obtain a mix of experience of preoperative medicine, palliative care and general medicine.

The full-time role (day shift, could be shared), is ideal for doctors who wish to leave general practice or who do not wish to pursue a specialty training position.

The full-time role will be supplemented by part time and night shift roster of doctors.
