

## ICT ADMINISTRATOR (Full time)

An opportunity has arisen for an experienced ICT Administrator to join our small professional ICT team that supports Bethesda's ICT requirements.

As the ICT Administrator, you will maintain and be responsible for infrastructure (including hardware, software and networking) to support more than 200 active users situated in Claremont and South Perth.

You will undertake ICT operational tasks including systems management, backups, patching, and will monitor and manage overall ICT security (endpoints, servers, networking and firewalls). You will be responsible for providing support to clients who use workstations and servers, and a range of applications and services including Microsoft Office, mobile and desk phones, and video conferencing facilities.

Outside of business as usual (BAU) activities, you will also be involved with the implementation of new software and hardware into the organisation.

Hours of work are negotiable, though dictated by organisation support requirements. As part of maintaining the ICT infrastructure, you will need to be available to undertake routine patching and updates out of normal operating hours as required, although a rare occurrence, you may be required to provide out of hours assistance for emergency issues.
