



# COVID-19 Information for Patients and Visitors

**As at 29 June 2021**

## Information for Patients

Elective surgeries are being managed in line with government directives. Your doctors rooms will be in contact with you if there are any changes to your scheduled surgery.

If you have attended, or been in contact with someone who attended, an exposure site or have any respiratory symptoms, please do not come into the hospital. Contact your doctors rooms or the hospital to reschedule your surgery.

Patients will be required to wear a mask at all times and complete a screening process, including temperature checks and specific questioning.

## Information for Visitors

Visitors are not permitted to enter the hospital as at 12:01am Tuesday 29 June 2021 until further notice. Exemptions will be permitted for end of life care or if you are accompanying a child. Exceptions on compassionate grounds may be granted on a case-by-case basis. This will need to be discussed with the ward manager and infection prevention and control.
