Dr Magtengaard, now a consultant Psychiatrist, served as a Commissioned Officer for ten years with the Royal Australian Navy before practicing medicine. He is an active member of the Australasian Military Medical Association (AMMA). He specialises in mental health problems in veterans, Defence personnel, first responders and their families. These include Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), Mood Disorders, Chronic Pain, Obsessive Compulsive Disorder (OCD) and General Adult Psychiatry.

The Bethesda Clinic, Cockburn, is well into its construction phase and is scheduled to admit patients from September 2022.

Dr Dharjinder Rooprai continues as our Director of Medical Services and welcomes Dr Magtengaard's appointment. Additionally, we thank and acknowledge Dr Taj Singh who has recently moved on from his position as Director of Partnerships to concentrate on developing his private business interests.
