CLINICAL

- Delivers mental health interventions for consumers of Bethesda Clinic through a variety of modalities
- Provides comprehensive evidence-based nursing care and individual management to consumers including assessment, intervention and evaluation.
- Undertakes clinical coordination of shifts at the direction of the Nurse Manager including participation on the after-hours/weekend roster if required
- Responsible and accountable for patient safety and quality of care through planning, coordinating, performing, facilitating, and evaluating the delivery of care provision at Bethesda Clinic
- Monitors, reviews and reports upon the standard of nursing practice to ensure that colleagues are working within the scope of nursing practice, following appropriate clinical pathways, policies, procedures and adopting a risk management approach in care delivery
- Participates in ward rounds/case conferences as appropriate
- Educates consumers/carers in post discharge management and organises discharge summaries/referrals to other services, as appropriate
- Supports and liaises with patients, carers, colleagues, medical, nursing, allied health, support staff, external agencies, and peer support workforce to provide coordinated multidisciplinary care
- Completes clinical documentation and undertakes other administrative/management tasks as required
- Participates in departmental and other meetings as required to meet Betheda Clinic and Recovery and Wellness Centre objectives
- Develops and seeks to implement change utilising expert clinical knowledge through research and evidence based best practice
- Monitors and maintains availability of consumable stock
