CLINICAL

- Works in accordance with the Mental Health Act (2014) and all other relevant legislation within area of practice.
- Undertakes clinical shifts at the direction of Senior Nurse, including participation on the afterhours/weekend roster if required.
- In collaboration with the Registered Nurse, implements evidence based therapeutic interventions (both group and individual work as part of the multidisciplinary team).
- Provides clinical care to consumers and support to their personal support persons through provision of appropriate information pertaining to processes, procedures and treatment.
- Ensures clinical documentation is completed in a contemporaneous manner and that changes in a clinical presentation and risk status are communication to the Registered Nurse and Shift Coordinator
- Assists the Registered Nurse, in collaboration with the consumer and personal support persons, to develop and update Treatment Support and Discharge Plans
- Participates in inpatient clinical processes including ongoing assessment, risk assessment and management, care planning and discharge planning of consumers of Bethesda Clinic, in collaboration with consumers and their personal support persons.
- Participates in quality improvement and policy review/development within the practice setting.
- Maintains the rights and safety of patients by providing an advocacy role.
- Complies with and demonstrates a positive commitment to Regulations, Acts and Policies relevant to nursing including the Code of Ethics for Nurses in Australia, the Code of Conduct for Nurses in Australia, the National Competency Standards for the Enrolled Nurse and the Medicines and Poisons Act 2014.
