About the role

Neuro-stimulation Coordinator - Clinical Nurse Specialist

This position is an integral part of Bethesda Clinic team. They will be responsible for the coordination of all aspects of Neuro-stimulation at Bethesda Clinic. They will play a pivotal role in our Electroconvulsive Therapy (ECT) service delivery which includes overseeing the safety and quality aspects of the service, liaison with consumers, carers, visiting medical officers (VMOs) including psychiatrists, anaesthetists and where necessary primary health providers. They will ensure equipment and consumable stock is maintained. They will coordinate the booking of all consumers, both inpatient and day patient, and staff required to deliver high quality and safe services, and will drive ongoing service evaluation.

The Neuro-stimulation Coordinator will be a clinical resource person in all aspects of ECT and will have extensive experience in the coordinator of this form of therapy. They will be committed to personcentred care that is trauma-informed and recovery oriented. They will facilitate information sharing groups for consumers and carers who are receiving or are considering ECT as a treatment option.

The Neuro-stimulation Coordinator will ensure that the service is compliant with requirements of the Office of the Chief Psychiatrist (OCP) WA pertaining to the administration of ECT and will ensure all required data is collected and reported to the OCP via the General Manager as well as Australian Council on Healthcare Standards (ACHS) clinical indicators related to neuro-stimulation.
