They will assist the staff to identify and manage clinical risk in line with policy.

The After-hours CNM will be responsible for the management of human resources after hours. They will work to ensure we deliver exemplary care and treatment that is evidence-based, and are driven to provide the highest quality, safe clinical care for every consumer, every time.
